WHY AN ASSOCIATION?

Why is it that former aircraft apprentices are willing to travel the length of the country - even across the world - to renew acquaintance with Halton.

There are as many answers to that as there are "Ex-Brats" here today, but it's a safe bet that the replies will concern gratitude for all that Halton did for us in our formative years and the hope of renewing those friendships that were fostered during apprenticeship.

It seems only right, therefore, that something should be done to keep such gratitude and renewal of friendships in being for longer than the few hours brought about by such get-togethers as we have today.

The need for an active organisation for ex-Aircraft Apprentices was stressed many times in countless letters received by the Reunion Committee after the reunion for Entries 1-55 in October 1978. Indeed, the hundreds of applications for membership of the proposed association have been strong proof of the need for such.

With help and encouragement from RAF Halton, and side by side with planning today's diamond jubilee reunion, the Reunion Committee have given considerable thought to the formation of an RAF Halton Aircraft Apprentices Association. You will all have received a copy of the suggested constitution together with an application form for membership.

At a meeting early this afternoon, it is hoped to get the formation of the association formally proposed, seconded and agreed, and officers elected to serve the first term of office. Having laid this foundation, those elected to office will become responsible.

Membership will, it is hoped, be numbered in thousands. An annual subscription was considered to be unworkable, so it was decided to ask for a registration fee of £1 per member, and to appeal for donations to the association as and when necessary.
